

बीएमएस/बीएचएमएस/बीयूएमएस/बीएनवायएस ऑल इण्डिया काउंसिलिंग से संबंधित  
दिशा-निर्देश

आयुष मंत्रालय भारत सरकार नई दिल्ली द्वारा जारी निर्देशों के अनुक्रम में आयुष मंत्रालय भारत सरकार व प्रदेश शासन से प्रवेशानुमति प्राप्त निजी आयुष महाविद्यालयों की 15 प्रतिशत सीटों की पूर्ति ऑल इण्डिया कोटे की काउंसिलिंग के माध्यम से एम0पी0 ऑनलाइन द्वारा संपन्न कराई जायेगी। उक्त काउंसिलिंग प्रक्रिया के संबंध में निम्नलिखित निर्देश जारी किये जाते हैं-

- 1- ऑल इण्डिया कोटे की काउंसिलिंग में सम्मिलित होने हेतु पृथक से पंजीयन कराना आवश्यक है।
- 2- पंजीकृत अभ्यर्थियों के आधार पर मैरिट जारी की जायेगी।
- 3- मैरिट सूची जारी होने के उपरान्त च्वाइस फिलिंग का ऑप्शन प्रदर्शित होगा।
- 4- च्वाइस फिलिंग हेतु केवल वही अभ्यर्थी पात्र होंगे जो स्टेट काउंसिलिंग के माध्यम से किसी भी संस्था में प्रवेशित नहीं हो।
- 5- च्वाइस फिलिंग के उपरान्त सीट आवंटन की कार्यवाही की जायेगी।
- 6- सीट आवंटन पश्चात् प्रवेश के समय अभ्यर्थी को संस्था के समक्ष समस्त आवश्यक मूल दस्तावेज प्रस्तुत करना अनिवार्य होगा।
- 7- ऑल इण्डिया कोटे की काउंसिलिंग संबंधी अन्य दिशा-निर्देश विभागीय वेबसाईट [www.ayush.mp.gov.in](http://www.ayush.mp.gov.in) पर उपलब्ध हैं।

Sub: Guidelines for State/UT Governments for Counselling of All India Quota Private UG & PG seats for academic year 2020-21 -Reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's letter issued vide ref. no. L.11011/02/2020-EP (1) dated 26.10.2020 regarding Counselling for admission in All India Quota seats of ASU & H UG and PG courses for academic year 2020-21.

2. In this regard it is informed that, for counselling of All India Quota seats of ASU & H UG and PG courses of Private Institutions other than Deemed University, Ministry has designated respective counselling authority of the State/UT Government. The guidelines for State/UT Counselling Authorities for conduction of Counselling of All India Quota Private UG & PG seats for academic year 2020-21 are annexed for your information and necessary action (copy enclosed).

**Guidelines for State/UT Governments for Counseling of ALL India Quota Private UG & PG seats for academic year 2020-21.**

- (i). State/UT counseling authorities shall conduct 02 Round for all India quota private seats and after 02<sup>nd</sup> Round, if all seats are not filled, these vacant seats may be converted into the State/UT Government quota seats for academic session 2020-21 and filled up as per State Counseling rules.
- (ii). State/UT counseling authorities has to provide sufficient time to NEET 2020/AIAPGET-2020 qualified aspirants for registration before each round of counseling for all India quota private seats as well as should give wider publicity for registration process. Details of the same may be shared with AACCC, Ministry of AYUSH on mail id [counseling-ayush@gov.in](mailto:counseling-ayush@gov.in).
- (iii). State/UT may decide an all-inclusive application Cost/Non-refundable Registration Fee for UG & PG seats for all category students. However, maximum ceiling limit for this fee will be Rs 2000/-.
- (iv). State/UT may decide refundable security money which will be refunded to candidates after joining the allotted college or if candidate did not get any seat during counseling. However, maximum ceiling limit for this fee will be Rs. 50,000/- for both UG & PG seats.  
This security money may be forfeited if candidate cancel his/her admission after round 2 of counseling. (Only during specific time period provided by State/UT authority)
- (v). There will be no requirement for any domicile certificate for allotment of seat in all India Quota Private UG & PG seats.
- (vi). Reservation for allotment of seat in all India Quota Private Seats: all seat in all India quota private (UG& PG) are open in Nature. However, relaxation in qualifying criterion may be provided category wise as mentioned in relevant regulations.

(vii). **Qualification Criterion: (As per the ASU & H UG & PG Regulations)**

a. **For UG Courses:** Passing marks for eligibility in admission to ASU & H UG courses should be as per the ASU & H UG regulations and should be followed strictly. The details qualifications for different categories are as follows:

- i. The candidate must have passed intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent examination recognized by the concerned State Government and Education Board with the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually.
- ii. Minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the aforesaid qualifying examination in the case of General category.
- iii. 40% Marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.
- iv. In respect of persons with disability candidate specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum qualifying marks in the said qualifying examination are as follows: a) In Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be 45% in the case of general category. (For PwD candidates only) b) 40% in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes. (for PwD candidates only).
- v. In order to be eligible for admission to under-graduate course for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in the 'National Eligibility Entrance Test for undergraduate course' held for the said academic year. Provided that in respect of- (A) candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile; (B) candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile in the case of general category and 40th percentile in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

**b. For admission to ASU &H PG Courses:**

- i. The candidate must have passed final year UG examination from a recognized University or Board or medical institution specified in the Schedules to the Act and enrolled in Central or State register of Indian System of Medicine and must have completed satisfactorily one year compulsory rotating internship in a recognized Hospital as on or before 31.12.2020 (for academic year 2020-21 only)
- ii. In order to be eligible for admission to post-graduate courses for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in the All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test (AIA-PGET) held for the said academic year: Provided that in respect of- (a) candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile; (b) candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile for the General Category and 40th percentile for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

(viii). For PwD candidates, PwD certificate should be as per the guidelines issued by Central Government and notified by the CCIM/CCH. (available on counseling website namely [www.aaccc.gov.in](http://www.aaccc.gov.in) under FAQs)

(ix). Candidates admitted in 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of all India Quota Private (UG and PG) can cancel their admitted seat with forfeiture of security money only during specific time period provided by State/UT authority. (State/UT authorities can decide this time period to cancel admitted seat after Round 2 as per their counseling schedule) After the said period, candidate will not be allowed to leave/surrender their admitted seat and also will be in-eligible for any further counseling.
